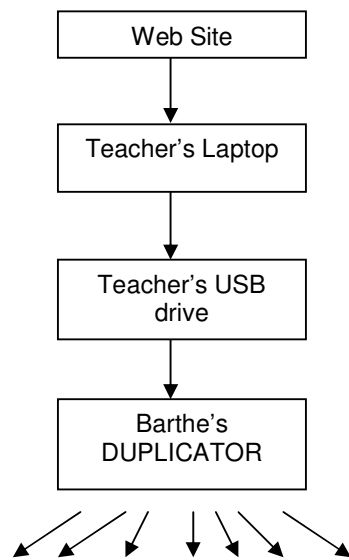

Abstract

The Company Barthe, manufacturer of audio equipment has developed the Duplicator, which allows the fast copy data from one Source up to 35 targets at once and collect data from up to 35 USB targets on to one drive.

For instance when a teacher wants to transfer a document which directly comes from Internet, the Duplicator finds its place in the podcasting chain

The Duplicator is a stand-alone system (no computer necessary). As simple to use as a **photocopier**, the aim of the duplicator is to facilitate the transfer of documents from the teacher USB device towards the students USB devices and **also** from the students' ones towards the teacher's one. It can duplicate any kind of audio or video data at the **touch of a button** to any USB flash media. It makes the relationships between teacher and students easier.

At the same time, the Duplicator allows to charge **batteries** of each Mp3 Player with control of the charge.

For instance some teaching situations where duplicator is necessary :

1- **The podcasting chain** (see above)

2- **Knowledge Control in classroom** : At the beginning of the class, the teacher distributes "MP3 proposal " and by the end of the class, he collects all audio proposals thanks to the Duplicator

3- **Oral homework with MP3 players** : the Duplicator allows to transfer the 35 audio proposals to the student's MP3 players and to easily gather in the work from the 35 students.
