Katri Oldendorff is the Managing Director of Lingonet Ltd, a multimedia publisher and developer focused on R&D of digital language learning resources. The company cooperates closely with various European publishers, the National Board of Education in Finland, the Ministry of Education in France and has participated in several language learning projects funded by the EU or other governmental institutions.

Katri Oldendorff graduated in History and German Language from the University of Turku in 2005 (M.A.) with the aim of becoming a teacher. In the 1990's she studied also at the University of Hamburg for 5 semesters. She has several years of experience teaching in schools, at the university as well as teaching Business German in the business world. She has also worked as a translator and interpreter (German – Finnish) for many years.

Katri Oldendorff has been working for Lingonet since 2000, first as a freelancer participating in the content and format development of German language learning resources. Since 2005, she has been at Lingonet first as a Manager for Multimedia Resources and since 2007 as the Managing Director. She coordinates a team of 7 in-house developers and a freelancer team of dozens of external experts for different languages or fields of profession. She has participated in over 30 development projects in Lingonet.
