Lloyd Bethell is a senior English lecturer at HAMK University of Applied Sciences (UAS) in Riihimäki, Finland. He is the team-leader for the English lecturers and a member of the Language Centre's development group.

Lloyd Bethell graduated with a Master's Degree in English Philology from Tampere University, Finland; a Bachelor's Degree (Hons) in physiology and a Post Graduate Diploma in health promotion (specializing in HIV/AIDS and workplace health promotion) from Aberdeen University, Scotland; and even studied theology in Helsinki University, Finland for 3 years, but didn't graduate.

Lloyd Bethell was born in the U.K. and moved to Finland in 1991 and since then has worked as an English teacher and consultant in various ministries, companies, banks, educational institutions and the Finnish Defence Forces. He started lecturing in HAMK University of Applied Sciences in 2002. He lectures in seven different degree programmes and is involved in projects that integrate these programmes and increase internationalization; he is developing English teaching and consultation to local companies through HAMK UAS; and is a leading developer of a national cooperation between English Lecturers at UASs (ETNA – the English Teachers' Networking Association). His main professional interests lie in e-learning, blended learning and internationalization.

Lloyd Bethell is also the vice chairperson of the Technical Language Teachers' Union (TOOL) and a member of the crisis management team in HAMK's Industrial Technical Unit, Riihimäki.
