He received a MA on legal sociology at the University of Bilbao in 1997, a LL.M on European Law at the European Academy of Legal Theory (Bruxelles) in 2000, and a Ph.D on legal sociology at the University of Milan in 2003. During the period from 1997 to 2010, while researching in communication science and legal sociology, he has constantly worked as IT consultant and project coordinator for the University of Urbino (IT).

Since 2004 he is coordinator of the first blended course in sociology, offered by the University of Urbino. His area of research includes studies on deliberative and participative democracy via ICT and the relationship between dyslexia and ICT.
