Lorenza Venturi is at present working in the Communication Unit of the Italian Lifelong Learning Programme National Agency, at Indire Agenzia Scuola, which manages the European Sectoral Programmes Comenius, Erasmus, Grundtvig and Study Visits.

After Liceo Classico, Lorenza Venturi graduated in Translation at the University of Trieste in 1990 with a thesis on language acquisition.

After an experience as literary translator for various Italian publishers (Guanda, Giunti, Salani) and doing editorial work for the Publisher Passigli, she started cooperating with Indire on editorial products linked to European programmes.

At present, she is in charge of the website, newsletter and publications of the LLP NA, besides other specific projects in the area of dissemination and valorisation and in the language field.

In the dissemination area, we can cite the European Shared Treasure, the database on partnerships and results in Comenius, Leonardo da Vinci and Grundtvig, www.europeansharedtreasure.eu developed by the Italian NA and now adopted by the European Commission for all the 33 countries participating in the LLP.

In the language area, among other initiatives she is in charge for Italy of the European Language Label, sector education, the European Label for innovative projects in language teaching and learning and Linguanet Europa, soon to become Linguanet World Wide, the multilingual, on-line resource centre for foreign language learning, developed over the years by a Consortium of 34 organisations from all over Europe.
