Tomasz Raczka is a lecturer in English language and Coordinator of English-medium studies at Warsaw University of Technology, and an adjunct lecturer at University of Warsaw. His research interests are in the methodology of teaching English for Specific Purposes and the use of ICT in teaching. He has written several papers on these topics and has presented them regularly at both academic and industry international conferences.

Much of his research and writing arose from his experience in developing and authoring several academic and professional courses to which he has received several awards – the most recent of which is the Vice-Chancellor Award (Warsaw University of Technology) recognizing his authorship and teaching of an innovative multimedia course, *English for Biotechnology*.
