



WHAT ARE COOKIES?

In order to make its services more efficient and easier to be used, this site uses cookies. Therefore, at each visit, in users' device a minimum amount of information is inserted, small text files named after "cookies", which are saved in the directory of users' browser.

There are several typologies of cookies, but they have a common goal: to improve the functionality of the website and to enable specific functionalities.

COOKIES AIM AT IMPROVING USERS' NAVIGATION. IN PARTICULAR COOKIES:

- allow an efficient navigation from one page to another
- store username and preferences inserted
- avoid to insert the same information (such as username and password) during the visit
- measure how web site' services are used, in order to improve both the navigation and the available services
- introduce targeted advertising information according to the interests shown during the navigation

TECHNICAL COOKIES

These cookies are essential in order to enable you to fully experience the website and use the features and functionalities available to you, such as access to secure areas of the website.

ANALYTICAL COOKIES

These cookies collect anonymous information about how visitors use a website, for instance which pages visitors visit most often, in order to provide a better user experience. These cookies do not personally identify individual visitors. All information these cookies collect is aggregated and anonymous.

TRACKING COOKIES

These cookies are used to collect information about how the website is used, what are the key words used to reach the site, and the most visited web sites. Information isare collected anonymously.

COOKIES FOR THE INTEGRATION OF THIRD-PART FUNCTIONALITIES

These cookies are used in order to integrate third-part functionalities on the website (for example, evaluation forms, and social network icons which allow end users to share the contents of the site).

Technical cookies do not require any consent from the end users, because they are strictly connected to the provision of the service. The other typologies of cookies need a specific consent expressed by the end user through specific programs and browser configurations. Preferences about cookies' policies can be modified in each moment. It is also possible to disable cookies from the browser, but this would prevent end user from using some sections of the website.

THIRD-PART WEBSITES

The current website contains links to other websites with a specific and proper privacy policy. The owner of this website is not responsible for privacy policies of linked websites. In accordance with article 122, second subparagraph of the legislative decree 196/2003, the consent to use cookies is expressed from the end user through an individual setting. The end user has the faculty to communicate how information collected through cookies should be handled.
