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MIN.01/BREEDTECH KOM/07/05/2024: Introductions: Partner Institutions Team members and Participants

The session chair Prof. Kimurto called the meeting to order at 0830 HRS by welcoming all the participants in *Building Capacity in Plant Breeding and Biotechnology Education and Research through partnership programme in Africa, Middle East and Europe for Agricultural Transformation* (BREEDTECH) Kick off meeting. This was followed by introduction of all participants from partner institutions both physical and online. The chair presented the meeting agenda and the program of activities which was ratified by the participants.

MIN.02/BREEDTECH KOM/07/05/2024: Presentation 1: BREEDTECH Project Overview by Dr. Miriam Charimbu

The Project PI Dr. Charimbu presented the project overview on Building Capacity in Plant Breeding and Biotechnology Education and Research through partnership program in Africa, Middle East and Europe for Agricultural transformation (BREEDTECH). This is a three-year cross regional project which has brought together a consortium of HEIs and a firm from Kenya, Ethiopia, Palestine, Italy, Sweden, and Serbia.

The PI also mentioned that the project aims in building the capacity in plant breeding and biotechnology education and research in Africa, the Middle East, and Europe and to involve African and Palestinian higher education institutions in the research movement related to plant breeding and biotechnology in Europe and to encourage researchers and academics to take an interest in the concept, domains, tools, and digital technology of plant breeding and biotechnology.

She also mentioned about the 4 work packages in the project and the institutions responsible for leading the work packages. Dr. Charimbu also presented the work packages, activities, resources and timelines, the BREEDTECH Governance structure and the overall Budget.

MIN.03/BREEDTECH KOM /07/05/2024: Welcoming Remarks by Director Research Prof. George Ogendi

The acting director research Egerton University welcomed all the BREEDTECH project partners and congratulated the team for winning the research funds. He noted that the project is multidisciplinary in nature and was value to African continent and the participating regions in general. The Director research mentioned that BREEDTECH project is timely as research in biotechnology especially in food security is a good opportunity to solve the challenges to achieve sustainable development goals leading to food security and addressing global challenges. He noted that it also creates opportunities for young scholars as it supports and provides mentorship to young scholars. The DCV AR&E welcomed the project partners to Egerton and Kenya at large. He mentioned that the BREEDTECH project aims resonates well with the activities at Egerton University and the institution will accord the necessary support to ensure the success of the project. He arecognized the presence and participation of Faculty of Agriculture by Prof. Joyce Ndemo and Faculty of Science by Prof. Joshua Kibet who are hosting the project. The two welcomed the partner institutions and emphasized on importance of networking and collaboration. The DVC AR&E then welcomed the Vice Chancellor Laikipia University to make his remarks.

MIN.05/BREEDTECH KOM/07/05/2024: Remarks by Vice Chancellor Laikipia University Prof. Joseph K. Rotich

The Vice Chancellor Laikipia University congratulated the BREEDTECH team and he noted that he was happy as Laikipia University is one of the partner institutions in the BREEDTECH project. Prof. Rotich noted that issues of hunger, food security, healthy diets food and nutrition security are a still a global challenge. Hence the timing of the project is spot on to diversify the research in plant breeding and biotechnology thereby contribute to development of resistance to plants and other products contributing to SDGs such zero hunger among others. He noted that curriculum/course development and review will immensely benefit the partner universities in order to deliver quality education to the students. He encouraged the team to collaborate and apply for more research funds. He noted that Laikipia University is open for more collaborations with all the partner institutions.

MIN.06/BREEDTECH KOM/07/05/2024: Presentation 2: Overview of Egerton University by Prof. Paul Kimurto

Prof. Kimurto gave a history of Egerton which was started in 1939 as a farm school by British colonialist Lord Maurice Egerton of Tatoon of UK and upgraded to Chartered as a public university in 1987. Egerton University is a leading Agricultural University in Kenya and also in Eastern Africa. He mentioned that Egerton has a student population about 17000 students, it consists of 10 faculties and 2 Directorates with 25 bachelors' programs, 89 master's program and 34 doctorates programs and over 550 Faculty members and 900 support staff on 1000 acre research and Teaching farm. Egerton University has research facilities in various fields such as molecular science and biotechnology, food science and dairy, food safety, social science, education and community development, engineering and technology, environment and natural resource, human and veterinary medicine, gender and development studies among others. He noted that the University is happy to hosst and lead the BREEDTECH Project under leadership of Dr Miriam Charimbu and Team members (Prof Paul Kimurto, Dr Maurice Oyoo, and Dr Mercy Wamalwa)

MIN.07/BREEDTECH KOM/07/05/2024: Presentation 3: WP1-Project Management and Evaluation by Prof. Paul Kimurto

The following was highlighted during the presentation:

Discussions and way forward

- Comment on dateline of reporting -overall is by EgU at what point do we agree as partner institutions for successful reporting according to the datelines
- Clarification on VAT is not uniform i.e which countries exempt the VAT for European funded project (respective team leads to check with the respective countries and then report to the project manager. The management board will agree whether to remove the clause from Project Implementation plan (PIP)
- **4** How to assign specific responsibilities for partners to evaluate
- In the governance of the project, if any MoUs need to be signed a draft can be developed and shared to all partners to adopt the same. The administrative systems of different universities are different and hence will be adopted in the governance structure.
- Possibility to change the equipment to current needs hence need approval from CBHE for changes
- Equipment to be purchased in the first year of the project







- Revise the proposal in terms of responsibilities and timelines and approve it by project management team

- Randa explained the meaning of the following formula in the budget sheet 3*1*4 (3 people, 1 meeting, 2 travelling days, 2 meeting days)
 (2*3*4) + (3*1*5) means (2 people x 3 meetings x 4 days) + (3people x1 meeting ,3 travelling days, 2 meeting days)

When interim final report will be submitted, the rationale clearly explained on the partner agreement on the website
- Purchase of lab equip not clearly explained -justify the equipment why and the purpose hence changes to be made indicate on interim
- Curriculum development explain the procedure for each partner country on the website where the new courses will be implemented
 - No clear indicators and in terms of disseminations the leader for WP4
 - How to implement the project websites (Miriam and Randa to discuss this)
 - More discussion on WP2 and WP3

MIN.11/BREEDTECH KOM/07/05/2024: Presentation 6: Draft Project Quality Plan Document by Dr. Lorenzo

Lorenzo presented the aspect of quality plan for work package 1 and 2 as follows

She presented the overview of the Santa Annah research Institute in Italy which is involved in WP2 on capacity building. Santa Annah institute will be involved in student and staff training for 5 days

- Dragana:would be good to have a template for training reports, as to facilitate creation of the final report
- Comments from Matteo: The document states that
- WP2 is led by SSSA, IFVCNS and ANNU. There are many activities under this WP, but it is not very clear to me who is in charge of each of them. Having multiple leads on a WP may be challenging, as partners may or may not act expecting others to perform tasks. I think that the earlier we assign specific responsibilities, the easier it will be for the partners to gauge what is expected from them. I see that Table 1 shows different partners assigned to different deliverables but perhaps it would be best if we could







specify tasks within WPs (which correspond to deliverables). It would also be useful to specify which partners are involved in which tasks/WP. For example, the text in WP2 also notes that " SLU and SAA to implement an upgrade of African and Palestinian HEIs research and laboratory facilities" but again it is not very clear to me who leads the process, who is involved, and ultimately who takes responsibility for the activity. To clarify who-does-what in a WP/task scheme would also help WP leads to understand with whom they need to interact to run the activities.

- On a side note, the timing of the deliverables may need to be reconsidered (I am referring specifically to D2.1, D2.2).
- Table 1 reports that D2.5 and D2.6, which are related to lab equipment, are under the responsibility of ANNU, but ANNU is not appearing in the text; rather SLU is, although they are not clearly stated as part of WP2. WP2- capacity building
- Ist March 1st August upload materials for training, needs assessment for target of staff to be trained, topics that fits the group, Santa'Annah to develop materials then adoption of the materials ready for uploading

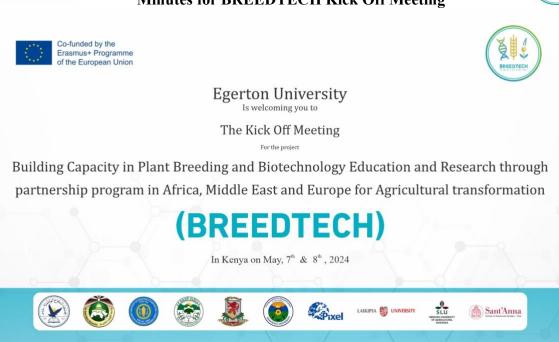
